



High School Graduation Bursary

To recognize the accomplishment of graduating high school or successfully completing the GED or Dogwood, and to encourage further education skills development by the graduate

Who is the program for?

The Citxw Nlaka'pamux Assembly (CNA) "We Did It" Program is a one-time cash award program designed to celebrate success and to support participating Citxw Nlaka'pamux Bands members who have successfully graduated high school, received their GED or Dogwood. It is a celebration of a great accomplishment.

How does the program work?

The program is a one-time bursary currently available for the 2011 -2016 academic years. The gift is given to individuals as a gift of \$500 in Canadian Funds and is available for students who have graduated. This is an open call and checks will be processed monthly at month's end.

Am I eligible for the Gift?

To qualify for the gift:

- Must have graduated 12 or successfully completed their GED or Dogwood from the years 2011 to the present
- Must provide proof a membership; preferably a valid Indian Status Card, of a Citxw Nlaka'pamux Assembly participating Band which include Ashcroft Indian Band, Boston Bar First Nation, Coldwater Indian Band, Cook's Ferry Indian Band, Nicomen Indian Band, Nooaitch Indian Band, Shackan Indian Band and Siska Indian Band
- Must provide a certificate of achievement from a recognized institute, or a certificate presentation of official transcripts / certificates clearly supporting successful completion
- Recipients are required to include a copy of High School Diploma or GED/ Dogwood Certificates at time of application,
- Must provide a letter requesting the bursary with complete return mailing address.
