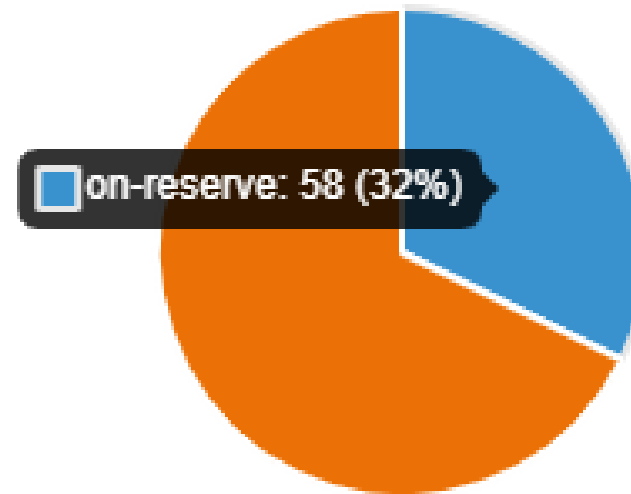

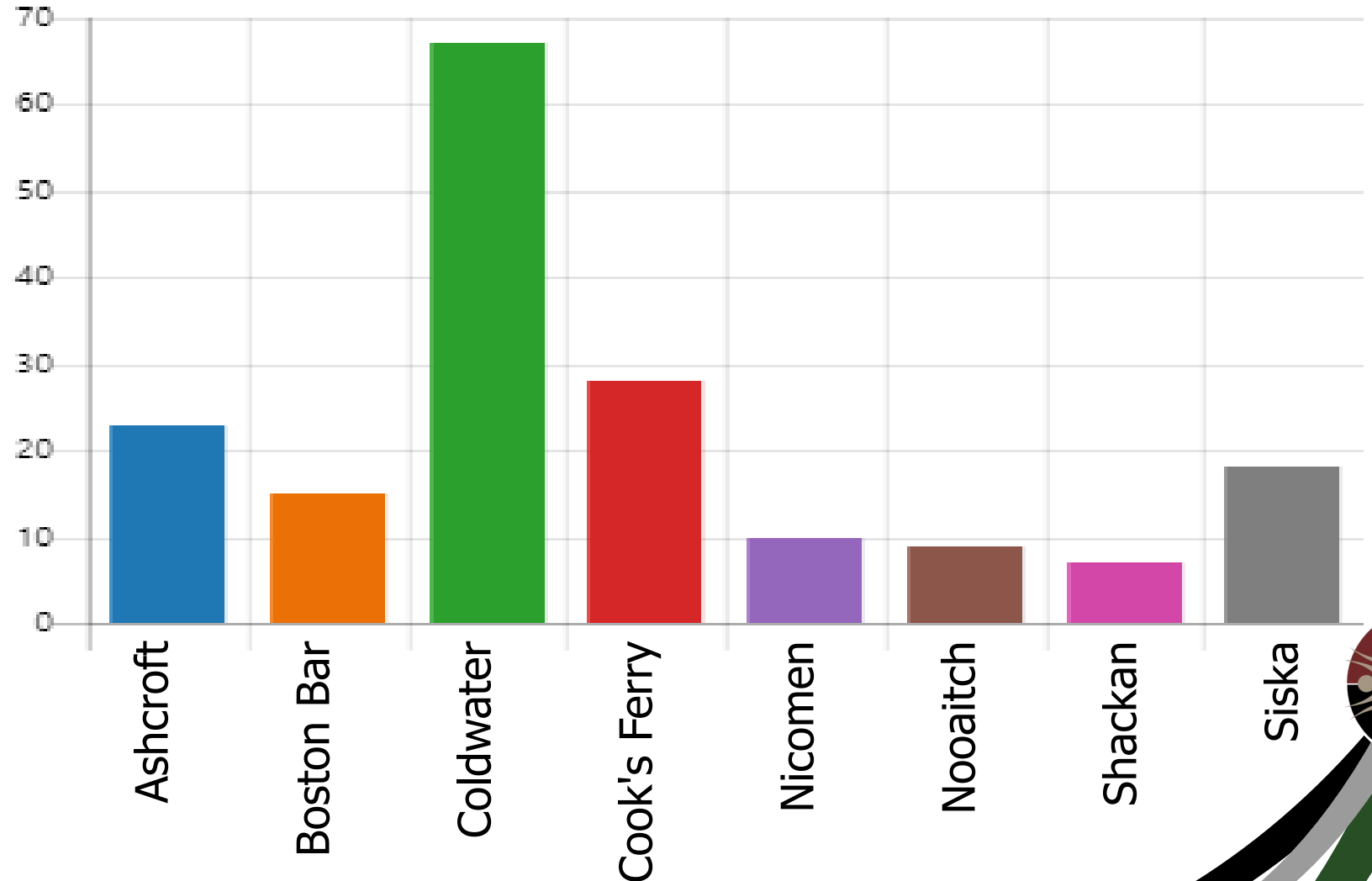

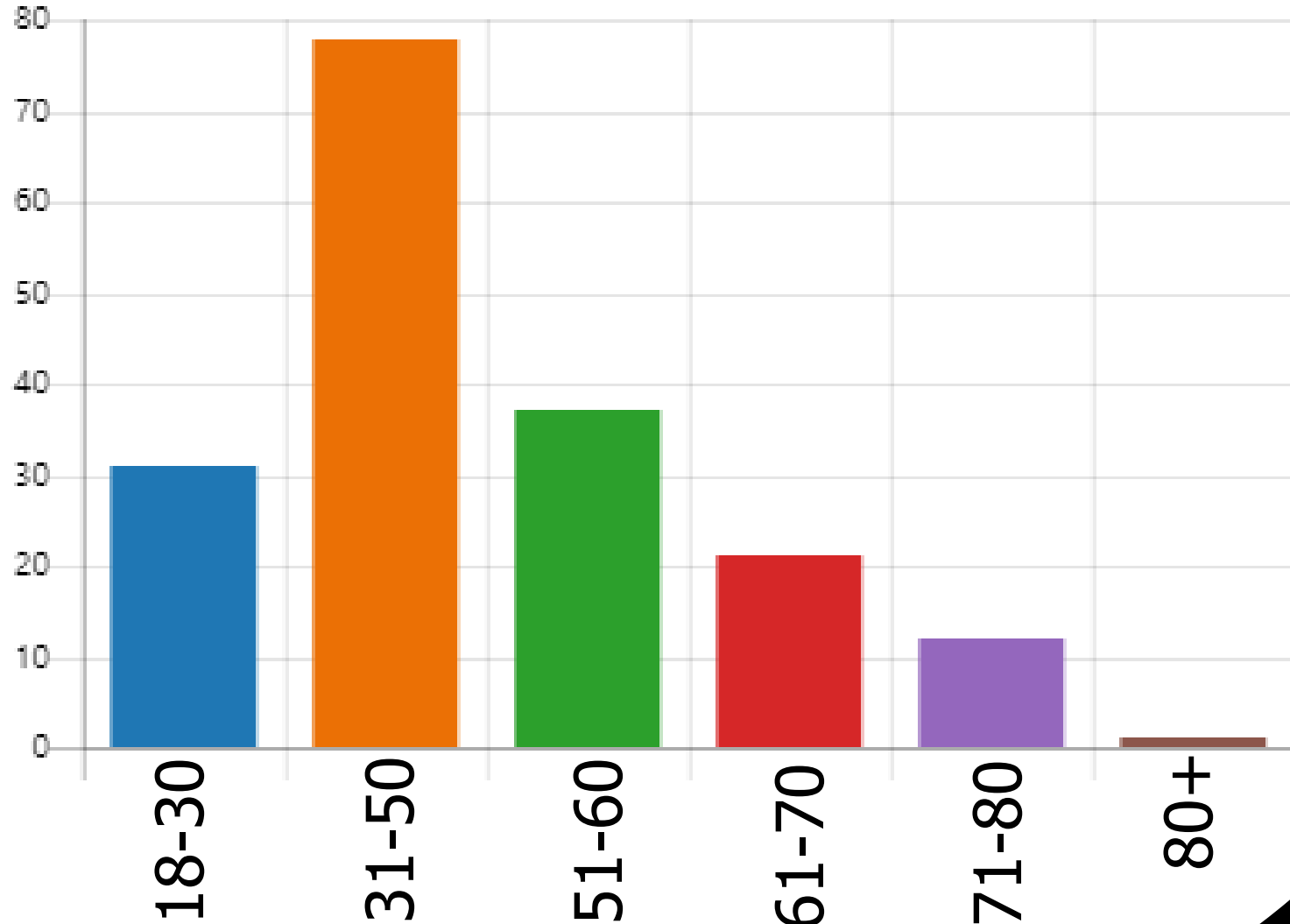

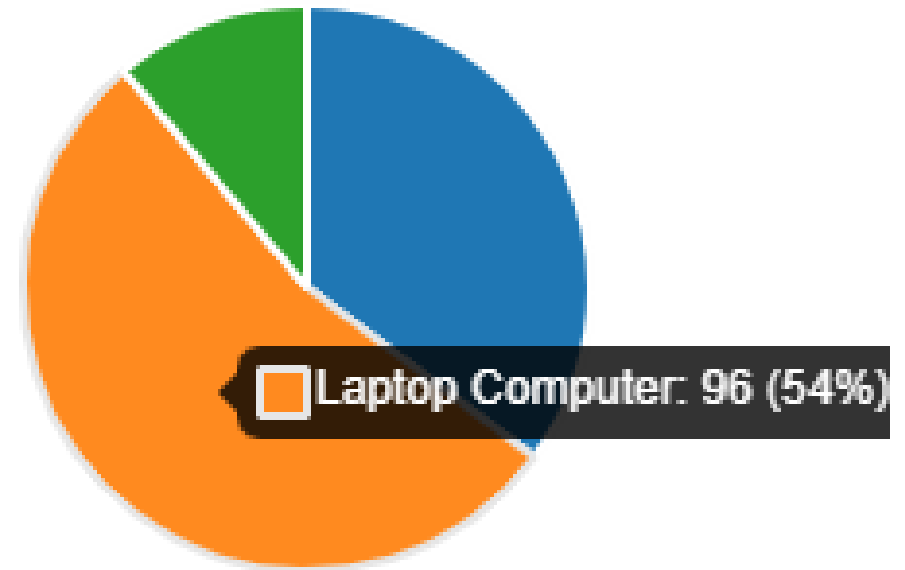

4. What type of technology are you most comfortable with?

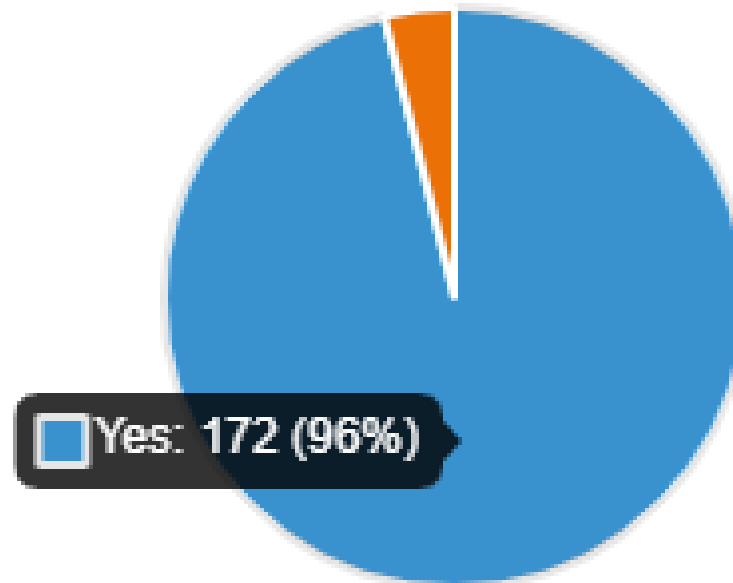

5. Do you have internet access at home?

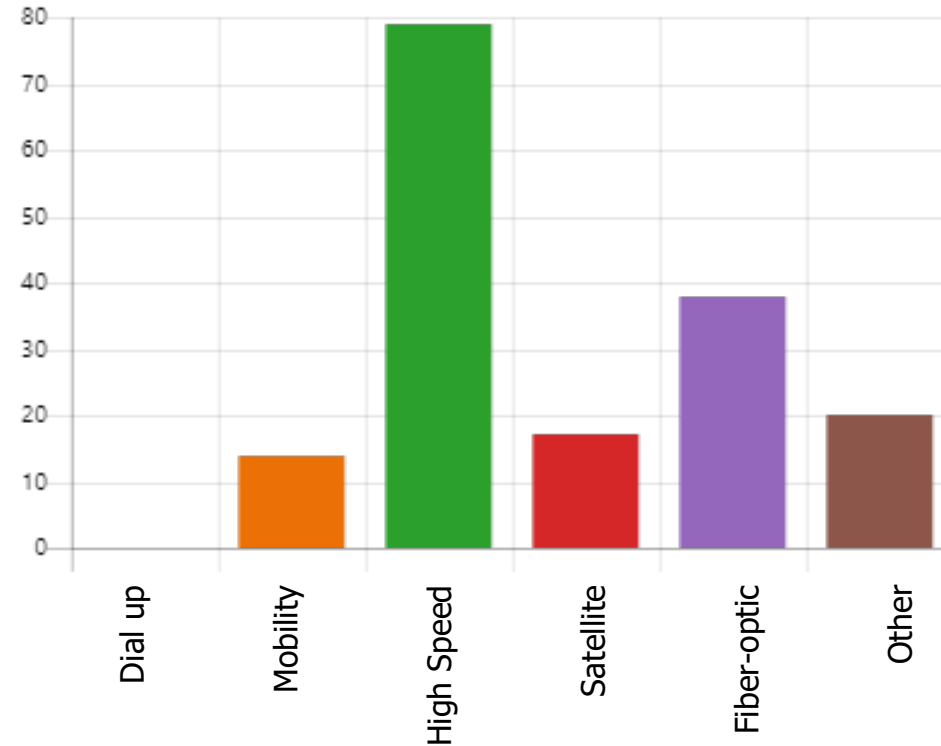
